## Activity Summary

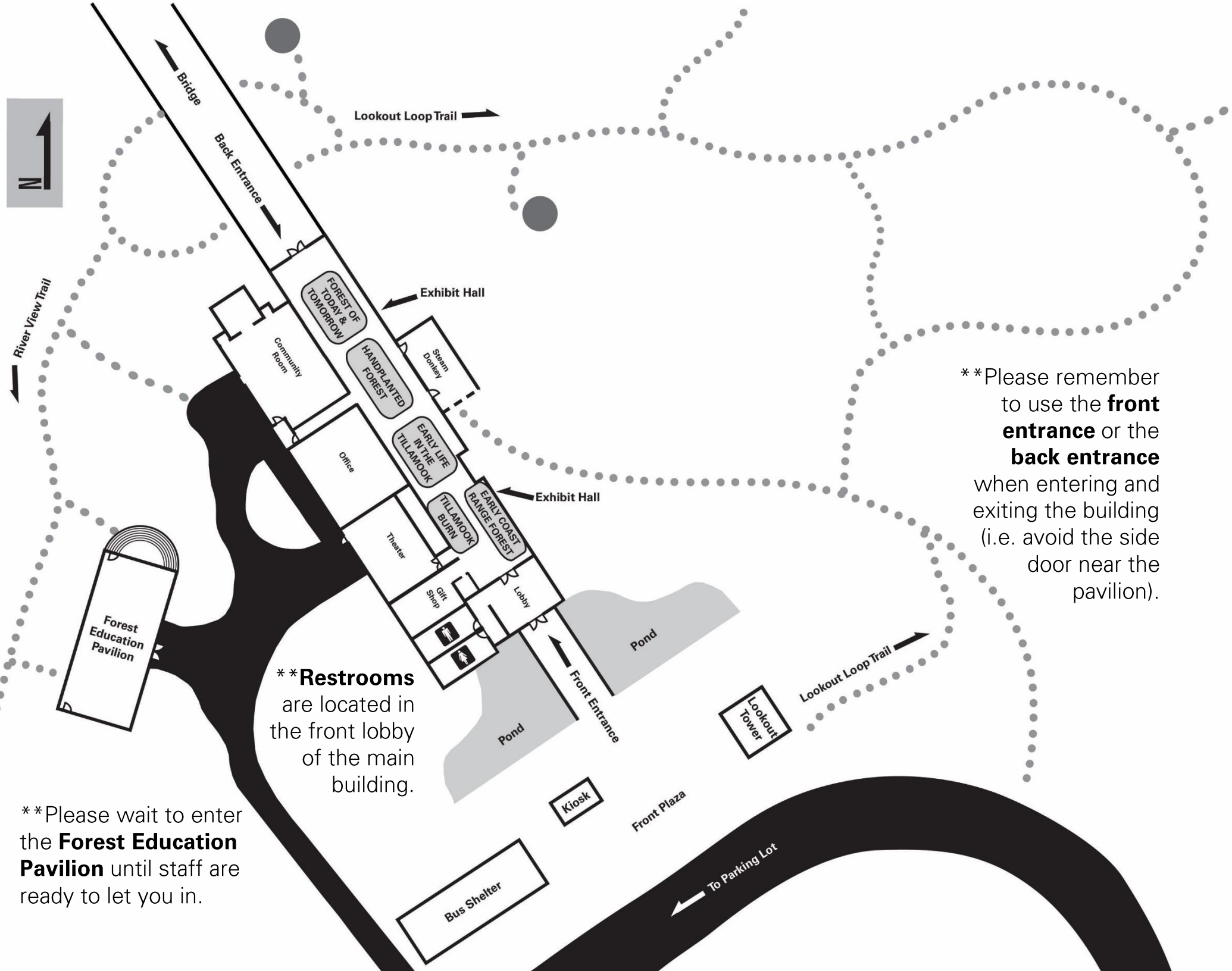
### Forest of ST Shrew Story Walk (TFC staff-led)

Students will be guided outdoors on an interactive story walk, where they will take a “shrew’s-eye-view” of life in the woods to gain an appreciation for the variety of living things that make forests their homes. Chaperones will assist as volunteers during the activity and help manage the students.

### Forest Habitats Scavenger Hunt (teacher & chaperone-led)

At the beginning of the rotation, half of the chaperones will guide their subgroups of students to explore the exhibit hall and the other half will explore the lookout tower. Students will record observations and discoveries in their scavenger hunt booklets (**provided**). Subgroups will rotate after 15 minutes spending half of the time in the exhibit hall and half of the time in the tower.
