Welcome to the Tillamook Forest Center! Follow the directions below to help you explore the forest and discover its hidden treasures. You will have fun and learn something new!



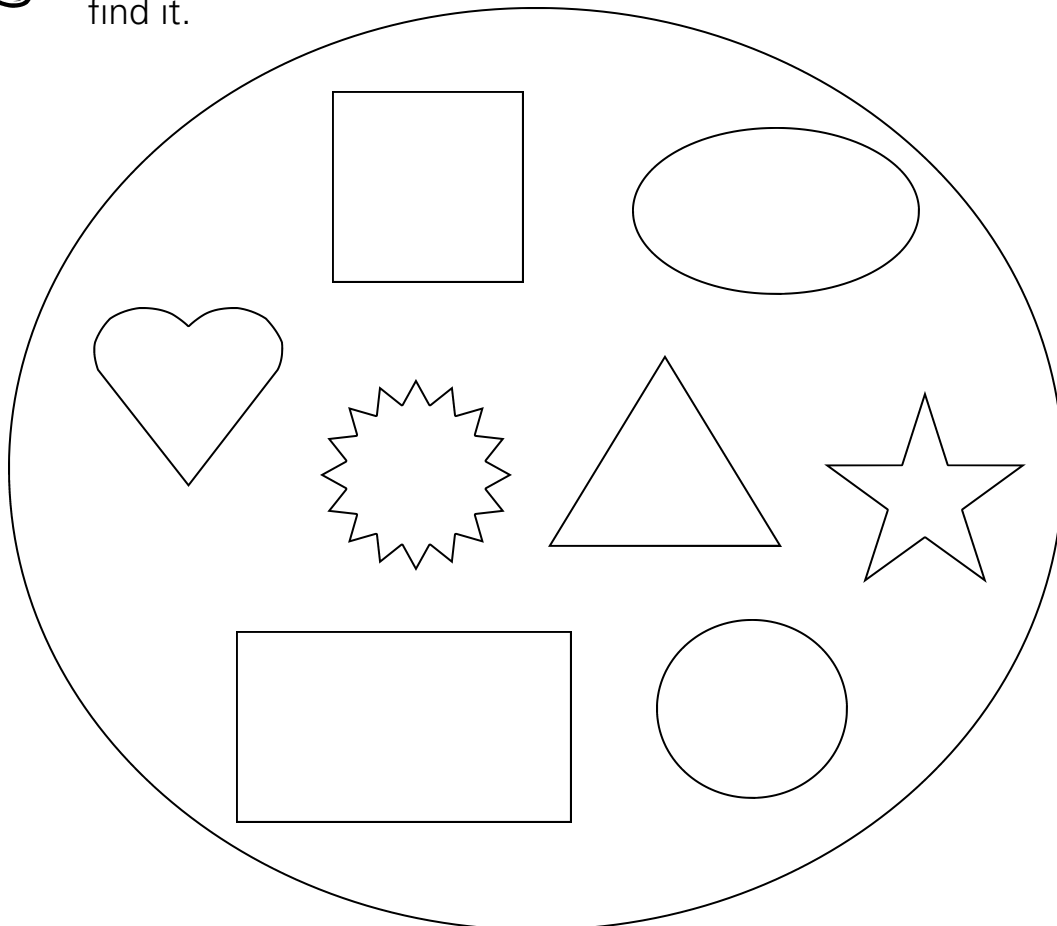

Look for natural objects in the forest that are similar to the shapes below. Cross out each shape when you find it.

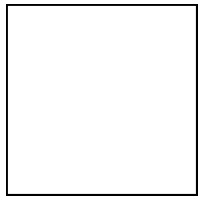




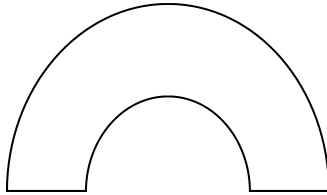

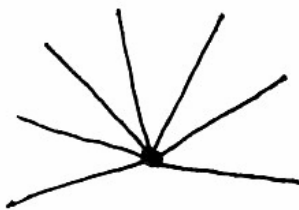

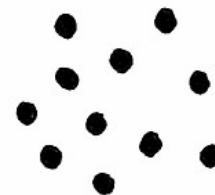
