Activity Summary

Dramatizing the History of the TSF Activity (TFC staff-led)

Students will dramatize a simplified history of the past 200 years of events on the Tillamook State Forest; from the early settlers clearing small areas for crops to the well-known fires and modern-day management activities. Chaperones will assist as volunteers during the activity and help manage the students.

TSF Past and Present Scavenger Hunt (teacher & chaperone-led)

At the beginning of the rotation, half of the chaperones will guide their subgroups of students to explore the exhibit hall and the other half will explore the lookout tower. Students will record observations and discoveries in their scavenger hunt booklets **(provided)**.

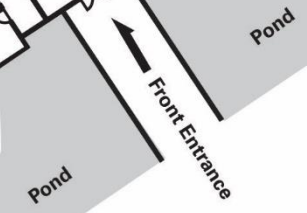
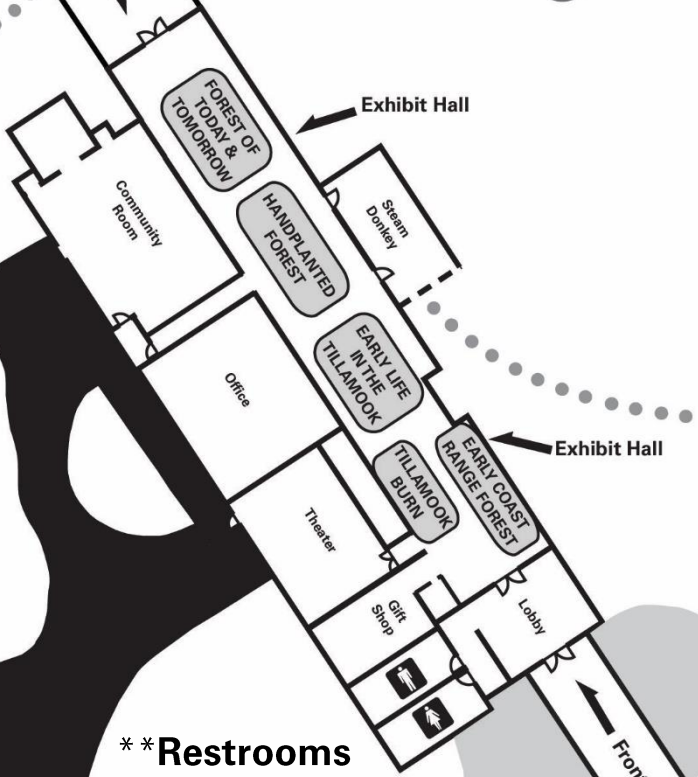
