Activity Summary

Safety & Respect "Hike" and Forest Products Activity (TFC staff-led)

Students will go on a short walk and find out how to be safe and respectful while recreating in the forest. Later, they will sort a variety of forest products into four categories: wood products, paper products, things we eat & drink, and non-forest products. Chaperones will assist as volunteers during the activity and help manage the students.

What's a Forest? Scavenger Hunt (teacher & chaperone-led)

At the beginning of the rotation, half of the chaperones will guide their subgroups of students to explore the exhibit hall and the other half will explore the lookout tower. Observations and discoveries will be facilitated by adults with the aid of the scavenger hunt booklet **(provided)**.
